BULK WASTE (ONLY) Verge Collection

May 2018

Council will provide a BULK WASTE COLLECTION for residential properties on the dates marked on the enclosed map.

Please follow these simple steps

to make collection easier:

1. Place bulk waste neatly on the street verge in separate piles of general household items, cardboard, whitegoods, metals, e-waste and plastics.
2. Keep bulk waste clear of sprinkler systems and do not obstruct the footpath or your normal bin service.

Remember

- Please do not place your waste out until the weekend prior to your collection date. This constitutes littering and is liable to incur a penalty.
- Waste put out after the specified dates may be collected but a fee will be charged.
- All waste must be neatly stacked on the verge BEFORE 7am on the MONDAY of your collection week.
- Collection will occur during the next 5 days.
- The truck will return to collect any metals and white goods left on the verge after your bulk waste is removed.

This bulk waste collection will remove:

- Old furniture
- Stoves and refrigerators (doors removed) and other white goods
- General household items, maximum length 1.5 metres (5 feet)
- E-waste - place in separate pile - household electronics including computers, printers, faxes, TVs and hi-fi equipment.
- Plastics including outdoor settings, buckets, plant pots, storage containers, Tupperware, paddling pools, polycarbonate sheeting, bottles and poly pipe.
- Mattresses
- Cardboard
- General junk
- Place white goods and e-waste together for easier recycling.

This bulk waste collection will not remove:

Residents can dispose the following FREE OF CHARGE at the Resource Recovery Facility:

- Cardboard
- Compact fluorescent lights (CFL)
- Electronic waste (computers televisions, printers)
- Household batteries (A, AA, AAA, C, D, button, 6V & 9V)
- Household hazardous waste (paint, chemicals)
- Lead-acid batteries
- Mobile phones
- Plastic containers
- Printer cartridges
- Scrap metal

A fee is payable for:

- General waste
- Green waste
- Asbestos (up to 3 sheets wrapped in heavy duty plastic)
- Gas cylinders
- Tyres
