Town of Cottesloe residents can now have their bulk and green waste collected at a time that suits them! Verge Valet is a convenient new service that allows you to book your waste collection when you want it. This fantastic new service began in July and has already been a great success!

Verge Valet replaces communal collections that were offered previously. This means that there is no longer a green collection in September or bulk collection in November. If you would like a green or bulk collection it can be booked in when it suits you!

IMPROVING BEACH ACCESS

Work has commenced on the construction of new stairs at the end of the access path at Cottesloe Main Beach. An excavator arrived in late August, with an archaeologist on hand due to the site being the location of the old Cottesloe Jetty. Burnt out timber was found under the concrete and long pieces of intact timber were uncovered under the sand. It's been confirmed that this timber is part of an old timber groyne that formed a retaining wall at the base of the jetty. The new stairs will provide convenient and safe access to the beach.
