Under the Cat Act 2011, cat owners must microchip, sterilise or desex their pets, and register them with their local Council before they are six months old.

A sterilised cat has; less chance of developing infections or some types of cancers, an increased lifespan, a reduced risk of loss or injury, no unwanted litters, a reduction in registration and vet fees and is a less temperamental pet.
